A bright, lively sparkling with lifted aromatics of nashi pear and acacia and a generous palate of golden delicious apples and roasted nuts.

2017 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY DAME NELLIE MELBA TRIBUTE BLANC DE BLANCS

Elegant, classic chardonnay characters on the nose, delicate white blossom and stone fruit, green apple, and fresh brioche. The palate displays fine minerality, lemon curd, ripe white stone fruits and toasted almond.

Subtle aromatics of plum dark cherries, warm toffee, purple plums, sawn oak with a lift of raspberry.

A medium weighted palate being bright rather than brooding. A pop of cherry and ripe raspberry, Christmas spice with a touch of marzipan.

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WHITE WINE

2021 MEDHURST SAUVIGNON BLANC

Fresh and pure aromas of grapefruit, tropical fruits, varietal grassiness, and spice. A wine with complexity but above all the flavour has intensity and a lovely weight.

2020 VALENTINE RIESLING

Layered and complex, it exhibits a range of fresh characters on the nose including melon, nectarine, and floral notes. Lean and lively with awesome length and a delicious, intricate finish.

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2021 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY ESTATE PINOT GRIS

Perfumed and aromatic on the nose, with notes of red apple, pear drop, acacia and spice. On the palate the wine displays refined complexity, with lemon citrus, grapefruit, and nuances of roasted macadamia.

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2021 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY ESTATE CHARDONNAY

Complex on the nose, with notes of white peach and green melon. Wonderfully complex palate, with rich stone fruits, lifted minerality and bright, biscuity oak that leads to a long finish.

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2021 MEDHURST CHARDONNAY

The nose is complex with hints of gunflint and stone fruit. Some classy French oak spice influence. The palate is poised and powerful, oak in the background helps usher the beautiful pure fruit to the back of a long and fine palate.

2021 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY TRIBUTE 'LADY PAMELA' CHARDONNAY

On the nose, the wine is rich with lemon pith, hints of lemon curd and biscuity oak. The palate is wonderfully bright, with generous white nectarine and toast balanced by clean, zesty acidity.

Light bodied and elegant with aroma of white flower, apricot, and nougat. Mineral and flinty with a hint of wood's spice. Poised and elegant with a mid-palate stone fruit, fine chalky phenolics on a long, mineral finish.

Showing opulent aromas of white blossom, stone fruit, and tropical elements. Full-bodied and textured, with layers of ripe apricot, honeysuckle, and sweet spice. Concentrated fruit character is balanced with fresh natural acidity and subtle phenolics.

Delectably dry Rosé from Pinot Noir fruit, lashings of wild raspberry, candied strawberry and rose petals, with a spicy, textural finish.

2022 SAVE OUR SOULS SANGIOVESE Aromas of violets and raspberry sherbet with black fruits including black cherry, black currant, and blackberry as well as subtle rose petal and earth.		65
2021 THICK AS THIEVES GAMAY 100% whole bunches. Blueberry and red berries mixed with cocoa and bay leaf aroma with an underlying mineral thread. Light bodied palate with raspberry, earth, and a touch of mint - super fine and savoury finish. Light, bright, and juicy.	14	70
2021 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY ESTATE PINOT NOIR Juicy wild red fruits accompanied by zesty cinnamon spice create a youthful compote of fresh red peppercorns and rhubarb. Balanced and textural with a long, elegant finish.	12	55
2018 PIMPERNEL PINOT NOIR The immediate notes are of cherry flesh, cranberries, and violets, contrasted by a touch of lees funk. Primary fruit characters are juxtaposed by rye bread and soft char. The acidity is bright with great line, leading to a long well-defined finish.	18	90
2021 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY ESTATE CAB SAV A medium to full bodied Cabernet which offers a melange of dark cherry, sour raspberry and roasted red capsicum. Velvety tannins and a warming cedary oak greet the palate, with briary herbaceous intrigue opening into rich, juicy blackberry and cassis.	12	55
2021 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY TRIBUTE 'LORD SAM' CAB SAV Elegant and powerful with ripe cherries and red currants merging with spicy smoked paprika and cinnamon. Generosity of sweet fruit with elements of crème brûlée and toast from oak, support the medium bodied palate in its intensity and persistence.	16	80
2021 COOMBE YARRA VALLEY ESTATE SHIRAZ Lively black fruited aromatics combine with supple raspberry and a hint of dark fruits combine for a classic cool climate, elegant, medium bodied wine.	12	55
2016 PIMPERNEL GSM (GRENACHE SHIRAZ MOURVÈDRE) The nose erupts with bramble fruits, graphite, and crisp red apples, progressing to rose petals, plum and dark cherry. The palate is all fruit with hints of vanilla with soft char notes of toasted almonds. Tremendous line and length.		90
2021 TIMO MAYER NEBBIOLO 100% whole bunches. A light, bright, cherry red. Aromatic, with red currants and red cherries, fennel seeds and a hint of Vietnamese mint. Light-medium bodied with grippy tannins.		110

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

The Coombe Farm Vineyards are located in the heart of the Yarra Valley. Just 5km north of the Melba Estate, the 120-acre Coombe Farm vineyard is one of the oldest in the valley, and is still owned and operated by Melba's descendants, the Vestey family. Having supplied grapes to some of Australia's most recognised producers, an increasing portion of fruit is now being grown and selected specifically for Coombe Yarra Valley Wines.

The soils are a combination of sandy loam to clay loam topsoils over a yellowish friable clay subsoil. The soils are well suited to vines growing premium cool climate grapes. Annual soil testing occurs with additions of minerals, trace elements and organic compounds to maintain the soil producing capacity.

The Chardonnay blocks are situated on the gentle lower slopes that range from 76 to 88 meters above sea level. Slopes generally fall to the south-west and south-east and result in a cool site to produce wine grapes.

The majority of Pinot noir is planted around the slopes of Mary's Mount. The blocks face north-west, west and south-west and range from 86 to 130 meters above sea level.

More recent plantings of Cabernet and Shiraz are on the warmer north-west slopes of Mary's Mount.

New plantings of Pinot noir are on the slightly cooler gentle lower slopes.
